First of all, July basho (tournament) of grand sumo will be held at Nagoya, Japan, beginning on Sunday, July 13, 2025. I added the latest 'banzuke' or 'rankings' of the top division called 'makuuchi' to the end of this article on 'kimarite' meaning 'winning techniques.'

It is important to know which kimarite a rikishi used against the other rikishi in a sumo bout. The following is a list of kimarite in a sumo bout, which I have compiled from watching Grand Sumo Highlights of NHK World-Japan TV program for many years. I also added historically existing names of kimarite although I had not watched those techniques through TV program in New York. You can notice those because there is no English translation included right after each equivalent kimarite. All I want you to do is use this list of kimarite as a glossary when you watch a sumo program in NHK World-Japan TV programs by cable or online.
